Once you have arrived at the portal, please complete the following steps to register:

If this is your first time attending you will need to set up GRA credentials – please follow instructions below:

 - a. Enter contact, organization information, and create a password
2. Once you have created an account and land on the Welcome page, click **Register for an event**
3. Select **2017 GRAORCA Retail Crime Conference**
4. Select Register Myself, answer the two questions on the page and click **Proceed to Checkout**.
